The Evangelical Lutheran Synod's **Board for World Outreach**, **(BWO)** administered by Pastor Tom Heyn, supports work in seven foreign fields in South America, Asia, and Europe. The work in South America is located in the countries of **Peru** and **Chile**.



Missionaries from the Evangelical Lutheran Synod first proclaimed Christ to the people of Peru in 1968. Today there are 7 churches with 6 active pastors, and 2 schools including the Lima area and the mountains. In the jungle there are 4 pastors, 3 congregations, and a school.



Chile was chosen as an alternative mission field and work began in 1993. We have 2 churches, one in Santiago, and the other in Linares, four hours away. We have one pastor, Mario Galvez who serves both congregations.





How is *Cross-stitch* involved in our missions in South America? There is one school, including elementary and high school students currently in the jungle. It is located in the community called Luis Terry. Cross-stitch provides money for food in order to meet the government's regulations in order to keep running.
